Thank you for participating in the Christmas Bird Count! Your efforts are greatly appreciated. As you may know, the count data you submit are used daily by conservation biologists and naturalists across North America (and around the world!) to assess the population trends and distribution of birds. In fact, the Count database is one of the **largest sets of wildlife survey data in the world**.

The Christmas Bird Count is coordinated in Canada by **Bird Studies Canada**, a registered charity. Every year, our team works to ensure accuracy of the data and encourage as many counts as possible to submit their reports. In the past, we have recouped some of the costs of coordination through the participation fees instituted by the National Audubon Society.

Starting in count year 113, we eliminated the fees. This has made the job of local compilers easier and brought in more counts to the database, making the count better than ever. It does, however, mean we have to find a new source of funding for the Christmas Bird Count. To that end, we are asking for voluntary donations to help fill this gap. <u>Any amount will help</u>!
