(CMMN-RCSM)

Criteria for Associate Members

Accepted – 23 May 2008

1. Associate Members are migration monitoring or research stations who have applied to and been accepted by the Steering Committee, or individuals that have been invited by the Steering Committee and have accepted Associate Membership.
2. Associate Members may include:
 - a. individuals, organized stations, or pilot stations, engaged in migration monitoring, banding, or research, that don't meet the criteria for provisional or full membership or do not wish to become full or provisional members;
 - b. individuals who are associated with full or provisional member stations and who are interested in participating more directly in the CMMN-RCSM.
 - c. individuals or organizations interested in contributing to the CMMN-RCSM in other ways; and
 - d. any other individuals or organizations that, in the judgement of the Steering Committee, would advance CMMN-RCSM interests through Associate membership.
3. Associate Members will:
 - a. receive copies of CMMN-RCSM reports, either electronically or as hard copies;
 - b. receive Steering Committee updates and news items;
 - c. receive technical advice upon request;
 - d. be invited to CMMN-RCSM meetings, if space permits;
 - e. be invited to participate in CMMN-RCSM collaborative projects, as deemed appropriate by the Steering Committee; and
 - f. will be accorded such other privileges as determined from time to time by the Steering Committee.
4. Associate Members will *not*:
 - a. be voting members of the CMMN-RCSM, nor vote to elect station representatives to the Steering Committee; or
 - b. be eligible for the special Birdathon privileges assigned to Full and Provisional CMMN-RCSM members.
5. Organizations designated as Associate Members will provide the Steering Committee with the name and address of one or two contact persons to receive CMMN- RCSM communications.
